Case has been heard through video conferencing in view of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

A short note on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed in
Court. Same is taken on record. At the outset, Mr. Mahajan points out that
though legislation has been enacted, it has been clearly laid down that it
shall come into force on such date, as the State Government may, by
notification in the Official Gazette, appoint. However, no such notification
has yet been issued. He has referred to Section 1 (2) of Haryana Official
Language (Amendment) Act, 2020 in this regard. He further submits that
proper procedure would be followed in the eventuality notification under
Section 1(2) is to be issued.

In view of above, we find that the writ petition is premature.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be
given liberty to file a fresh one in case notification as aforesaid is issued.

Petition is disposed of with liberty as aforesaid.
