The present petition is filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.145 dated 25.09.2019 under Sections 364/323/341/342/506/148/149 of IPC, registered at Police Station, Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

Issue notice of motion.

Mr. H.S. Grewal, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

The factum of compromise is not disputed.

Accordingly, taking into account the facts of the present case as also the compromised, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within a period of two weeks and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In case, the petitioner does not join the investigation or does not cooperate in the investigation, the respondent/State shall be at liberty to file an application for cancellation of his anticipatory bail.
