This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No. 167 dated 02.05.2020 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 312, 313, 315 and 316 of IPC 1860 and Section 23 of the Pre Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulation and Prevention of Misuse) Act, 1994 registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in custody since 02.05.2020.

Learned counsel for the State informs that challan has been presented against the petitioners on 26.06.2020.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this facts is not in dispute that one Sukhpal Kaur wife of Harpreet Singh, resident of District Bathinda, Punjab who was allegedly pregnant with twins, approached the petitioners to consult about her health. She was taken away from the house of the petitioners and the police arrested the petitioners. Thereafter she was admitted in Civil Hospital, Sherpur by the police of Police Station Sadar Dhuri and her abortion was carried out later in the said hospital.

Keeping in view above facts and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion after presentation of challan, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioners any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
