Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through instant second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.91 dated 25.07.2016, registered under Sections 302, 307, 447, 506, 511, 120-B, 148, 149, 34 IPC and 25 & 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel contends that four co-accused of the petitioner namely Usha Rani, Anita, Shubham Garg and Ram Chand have been enlarged on bail vide orders dated 21.12.2018, 22.01.2019, 15.02.2019 & 03.10.2019 in CRM-M-57235-2018, 904-2019, 6382-2019 & 13368-2019 respectively. Petitioner is in custody since 26.07.2016. Conclusion of trial may take sufficient long time.

No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any

more in jail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, treating the case of the petitioner on the same parity as that of his above-named co-accused, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner Kuldeep Singh Bhullar is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
