The prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.88 dated 12.6.2015 under Sections 302, 307, 506 and 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga.

As per the statements of the eye-witnesses and the allegations, it is the present petitioner, who has been attributed fire arm injuries. He fired four shots. The argument that the co-accused have been acquitted does not help as they have been enroped under Section 120-B IPC and the evidence of conspiracy could not be established.

In view of the above, no ground for bail is made out.

Dismissed.
