The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the order dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-1) vide which the petitioner has been transferred from NROL, Mohali to FMCD, Delhi Port in violation of the placement policy of Group A, Scientist Cadre Officers dated 02.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) and to direct the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue at his earlier place of posting.

Mr. Anil Chawla, Senior Panel Counsel has on instructions from the respondents submitted that the petitioner can be accommodated in the Secretariat of the Deputy Director General (North) at Chandigarh till 31.03.2021.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that in case

examination of the daughter of the petitioner is not concluded by 31.03.2021, in that eventuality, respondents may be directed to allow extension to the petitioner for an appropriate period till conclusion of the examination as per the date sheet thereof and subject thereto the grievances of the petitioner stands satisfied and the petition may be disposed of accordingly.

In view of the statements of learned Senior Panel Counsel for respondents and learned Counsel for the petitioner, the respondents are directed to accommodate the petitioner in the Secretariat of the Deputy Director General (North) at Chandigarh till 31.03.2021. In case examination of the daughter of the petitioner is not concluded by 31.03.2021, the petitioner shall be granted extension of an appropriate period till conclusion of such examination as per the examination date sheet. Transfer of the petitioner to FMCD Delhi Port shall remain in abeyance till relieving of the petitioner in accordance with this order.

The petition is accordingly disposed of with abovesaid directions.
