The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.058, dated 21.10.2018, under Sections 406, 498-A, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar.

The matter had been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court vide order dated 1st October, 2019. As per the report received from the said Forum, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to the proceedings before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, the parties have decided to file a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

Learned counsel for the complainant also does not dispute the factum of compromise having been arrived at between the parties and does not controvert the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for petitioner has handed over a bank draft bearing No.000288 dated 05.03.2020 amounting to Rs.3,00,000/- to the complainant-wife, who is present in the Court today, as per the settlement arrived at before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 3rd April, 2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
