The present petition is filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0134 dated 07.04.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 188, 323, 324, 326, 307, 506 of IPC and 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station, Indri, District Karnal

Issue notice of motion.

Mr. Ramesh Kumar Ambavta, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

The allegations in the FIR are serious. A number of persons together after being armed with deadly weapons inflicted injuries on the complainant side. The petitioner too is stated to have inflicted injury on Sagar with a cutter. The argument that the petitioner is not seen in the video or the CD produced by the Investigating Officer is disputed as there were other CDs in which his presence has been duly noticed at the spot. The weapon of offence is yet to be recovered.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant him anticipatory bail.

Dismissed accordingly.
