The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.191 dated 23.8.2019 registered under Sections 302, 34 of IPC (Section 34 deleted later on) at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

Admittedly, it is a blind murder. The petitioner has been arrested on suspicion. The only evidence pointed out against him is the disclosure statement of the petitioner and in pursuance to the same, telephone of the accused and some blood stained clothes worn by the accused were recovered. On the last date of hearing, this Court directed that the State to place on record the FSL report of the blood stained found on the recovered clothes. As per the FSL report, the result is inclusive and the material is disintegrated. No other evidence has been found.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
