Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Application is allowed as prayed for.

The accompanying amended Memo of Parties is taken on record.

Application is disposed of.

Main case:

Petitioner seeks regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.730, dated 18.12.2019, under Sections 395/386/365/342/506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Jind, District Jind.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Prosecution version is that Wazir Singh was robbed of a cash amount of Rs.14 lakhs approximately on the threat of a fire arm by Amit @ Mitu and 3 others.

Present petitioner was arrested on 20.12.2019 and from whom a recovery of Rs.28,000/- is stated to have been made.

Two co-accused, namely, Sahil and Lakshya against whom there were similar allegations have been granted benefit of bail by the trial Court. It may however be noticed that such benefit has been granted primarily on the basis that they were juveniles.

Be that as it may, investigation in the present case is already complete and challan has been presented.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that till date no prosecution witness has been examined.

Keeping in view the current Covid-19 situation, the trial is bound to take time to conclude.

Present petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other criminal proceedings.

In view of the above and coupled with the period of incarceration already suffered and without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Jind.
