Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take appropriate strict legal action on the representations dated 11.05.2020 and 04.06.2020, filed by petitioner, against respondent Nos.4 to 8, for registration of false cases against her.

Allegations against Sub Inspector Karampal Singh

Randhawa wrongly mentioned as Kamaljeet Singh Randhawa (respondent No.4), ASI Jagjit Singh and Lady Constable Kiran, respondent Nos.5 and 6 are very serious in nature.

Prima facie, the story put-forth by petitioner proves callous and malafide attitude of abovesaid police officials. Therefore, respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, Punjab is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate action on the representation (Annexure P3) of petitioner by passing a speaking order within two months from today. It is further observed that respondent No.3 shall not try to help his above mentioned subordinates in any manner. In case, any such thing is brought to the notice of this Court, the same would be viewed seriously. He will give a patient hearing to petitioner before deciding her representation.
