The petitioner has filed the present petition for setting aside the order dated 5.12.2019 passed by the Trial Court and the order dated 15.1.2020 passed by the learned Sessions Judge. The petitioner had prayed for releasing the vehicle on superdari. Learned Sessions Court has allowed the revision petition and ordered that the petitioner can take the vehicle i.e Accent car on superdari after furnishing bank guarantee in the sum of Rs.2 lacs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the amount is excessive.

This Court does not have any mechanism to assess what is the value of the car. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.
