(1) The petitioner Gurpreet Singh aged about 35 years *inter alia* seeks a direction to the respondents to take remedial action with regard to the complaint/application dated 18.09.2019 (P2) submitted by the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that this complaint/enquiry was also conducted and a report dated 20.12.2019 (P6) is available but since then, till date, no further action has been taken.
