1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.

2. Challenge is to order Annexure P/7 dated 13.11.2019, transferring the petitioner from Forensic Science Laboratory, Madhuban to Regional Forensic Science Laboratory, Bhondsi, District Gurugram. Prayer is also to quash the impugned relieving order Annexure P/8 dated 09.03.2020.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that since the petitioner has already joined service at Forensic Science Laboratory Bhondsi, he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file representation against the impugned order with a direction being issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the

representation by passing a speaking order in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Ms. Palika Monga, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that she has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

6. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit representation to respondent No.2 within one week from today. On receipt of representation, respondent No.2 shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law within two weeks thereafter.
