The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.235 dated 27.06.2014, under Sections 22/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Amritsar, District Amritsar.

[2]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits, *inter alia*, that the petitioner had earlier been granted bail by this Court in this case in CRM-M-43413-2017 on 24.11.2017. He, thereafter appeared before the Ld. Trial Court, but could not appear on one occasion as at that time, he was in detention in some other case.

[3]. In such circumstances, absence of the petitioner on the solitary occasion, on which date his bail was cancelled, does not appear to be willful.

[4]. For the aforesaid reasons, the petitioner's prayer for fresh bail, at this stage, is allowed. He is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
