The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the respondents to set up a Special Investigation Team to look into the allegations levelled against the petitioners by respondent No.2 in FIR No.104 dated 23.10.2019 under Sections 313, 323, 498-A, 506 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC pending in Police Station Women Cell, Kurukshetra and also in FIR No.301 dated 10.06.2020 pending in Police Station Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 452, 376 & 120-B IPC.

Learned State counsel submits that in FIR No.104 dated 23.10.2019, the petitioners have been found innocent and in FIR No.301 dated 10.06.2020, the Police has prepared a cancellation report.

Faced with situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the fact that in FIR No.104, the petitioner has been found innocent and in FIR No.301, cancellation report has been submitted, the present petition has been rendered infructuous qua the petitioners.

Disposed of being infructuous.
