1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.

2. Learned counsel contends that transfer of the petitioner vide order Annexure P/11 is in derogation of the instructions Annexure P/10 dated 26.08.2019 and that the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit a comprehensive representation to respondent No.2 and directions being issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the same on receipt since subsequent to order Annexure P/11, developments have taken place in the case.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Deepak Balyan, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 and 3 and states that he has no objection to the aforementioned prayer of the learned counsel.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit a representation to respondent No.2 within five days from today and on receipt of representation by respondent No.2, the same shall be considered and decided by respondent No. 2 in accordance with law within a period of two weeks thereafter.

6. Writ petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
