The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.260 dated 28.04.2020 on the file of Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat, registered under Sections 457 and 380 IPC (Sections 120-B and 406 IPC added later on). By way of this petition, he seeks grant of regular bail.

The petitioner has been in custody since 11.05.2020. This Court is informed that the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted bail, subject to conditions. Further, Mr. Anant Kataria, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, informs this Court that recoveries have already been effected insofar as the petitioner is concerned. In consequence, his custodial interrogation may no longer be required for that purpose.

Given these circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that the

petitioner would be entitled to relief, subject to conditions.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on regular bail in FIR No.260 dated 28.04.2020 on the file of Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat, upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Duty/Illaqa Magistrate concerned. Further, the petitioner shall not cause any threat, inducement or promise to any person involved with the case.
