All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail upon FIR No.75, dated 19.5.2020, having been registered at Police Station Satnampura, District Kapurthala, against her, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 315/316 read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely impleaded and in fact the complainant had been advised bed rest during her pregnancy and consequently she has made false allegations against the petitioner and her son, i.e.the husband of the complainant, as regards any harassment for dowry, or with regard to the injuries caused to her(as alleged) leading to abortion of her child/giving birth to a stillborn child.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, I find no reason to entertain this petition, at the threshold itself, in view of the fact that it is very difficult to believe that a woman who is pregnant and has lost her child would falsely accuse her husband and mother-in-law of causing the child to be aborted or to be born stillborn, especially when her elder sister is married in the same house, and with the complainant shown to be in a bleeding condition when she was brought to the hospital. Consequently, finding no merit, the petition is dismissed *in limine*.

However having said that, it is made absolutely clear that this court has not made any observation on the merits of the case, which would obviously be subject matter of the evidence brought before and to be considered by the trial court, with all observations made hereinabove being wholly and completely in the context of a petition filed under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C.
