(1) The petitioner Rajnish Kumar Jasra stated to be aged 61 years has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondents to count the entire service rendered by him with PUNWAC for the purposes of grant of pensionary benefits as well as increments and also for further benefit of 4-9-14 service with all consequential benefits.

(3) On the asking, Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl. AG Punjab accepts notice through video conferencing.

(4) Learned counsel submits that for the same/similar relief, the petitioner has submitted a detailed representation dated 10.03.2020 (P8). He further submits that along with the said representation, supporting judgment on the point has also been appended.

(5) Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the submissions/prayer made in the representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

(6) Considering the present situation due to Covid-19, learned State counsel and the Registry is directed to send an email to the concerned authorities for necessary compliance.
