1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.

2. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to pay full salary to the petitioner i.e. Rs.57,700/- per month for the period 14.02.2020 to 31.05.2020 along with interest @ 12% per annum and further to direct the respondents to take a final decision on the petitioner's representation's, Annexure P/6 to P/8 dated 17.03.2020, 29.04.2020 and 21.05.2020 respectively, by passing a speaking order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representations

Annexure P/6 to P/8 dated 17.03.2020, 29.04.2020 and 21.05.2020 respectively, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representations Annexure P/6 to P/8 dated 17.03.2020, 29.04.2020 and 21.05.2020 respectively, in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. Writ petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
