The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.27 dated 10.03.2020 registered under Sections 324, 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

On 23.06.2020, following order was passed:-

*"This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 27, dated 10.3.2020, registered under Sections 324, 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.*

*Learned counsel for petitioner inter alia contends that injury with brick on the head of son of*

*complainant has been attributed to co accused of petitioner, namely, Paramjeet Singh.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr. H.S. Sullar, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent State.*

*List on 19.8.2020.*

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join investigation. In the event of his arrest, he be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He will abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and co-accused namely Paramjeet Singh has been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M No.12785 of 2020 vide order dated 05.06.2020.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 23.06.2020 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer.
