Petitioner has filed this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order of dismissal from service dated 24.12.2019 (Annexure P-1).

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by Mr. Sameer Sachdeva that the order of dismissal from service passed against the petitioner on 24.12.2019 is appealable. It is pointed out by the learned counsel that the claim of the petitioner is pending before the Director General of Police, Punjab.

In view of the above, no case is made out for invoking the extraordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 Constitution of India. It shall be open for the petitioner to pursue his remedy before the Appellate Authority against the impugned order.
