The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.6 dated 11.01.2020, under Sections 21 and 29 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran or in the alternative seeking interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The recovery which was effected from the petitioner is 178 grams of heroin. The wife of the petitioner is pregnant and delivery is due on 20.09.2020.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran which indicates that the petitioner is involved in two other cases under the NDPS Act wherein 30 grams and 15 grams of heroin were recovered from him.

In view of the involvement of the petitioner in other cases as well as for possession of heroin, the petitioner is not entitled to be released on bail at this stage.

The delivery of the wife of the petitioner is expected in about two months, therefore, there does not seem to be any immediate necessity for release of the petitioner on interim bail at this stage.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed at this stage.
