1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.32 dated 18.02.2020, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, 1860, at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 22.06.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Ajay Rajan states that, pursuant to the order of this Court dated 22.06.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and was granted ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the position as noted above, order dated 22.06.2020, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
