Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the official respondents to register an FIR under Section 302, 120-B and 34 IPC against respondents No.3 to 5 and to conduct the investigation in a fair and impartial manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondents No.3 to 5 took Ajay, son of petitioner, to attend a marriage and the story put forward by them that he died due to accident, is incorrect as there is no evidential justification. The petitioner apprehends that the private respondents killed his son because they had a fight with the deceased on the day of Deepawali and they threatened to kill him.

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At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she would be satisfied, if representation dated 12.03.2020 (Annexure P-6) given by the petitioner to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat, is decided within a stipulated period after taking into consideration all the aspects.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat, to decide the representation dated 12.03.2020(Annexure P-6), moved by the petitioner, within one month of the receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law.
