On 10.07.2020, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.55, dated 12.05.2020, registered under Sections 148/149/188/323/324/326/447/506/511 IPC, at Police Station Kunjpura, District Karnal.

In a nutshell, the case of the prosecution is that on account of dispute with regard to demarcation of agricultural land and its boundary, the owners of the adjoining land entered into a scuffle.

Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged main accused-Randhir Singh was arrested and thereafter, released on regular bail. He further submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

On the request of this Court, Mr. Kuldeep Tiwari, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called

upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ram Mehar, has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation, cooperated and are not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, the interim order dated 10.07.2020, passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
