A negative report regarding compromise has been received in the present petition from the Appellate Court, which has been filed for quashing of the FIR, on the basis of compromise, as the conviction had been recorded by the Trial Court.

The complainant had appeared before the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur and submitted that there is no compromise, which has been effected.

Resultantly, counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition, in such circumstances.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the condition that the petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.20,000/- as costs, to be deposited with the Appellate Court, within a period of 2 months for wasting judicial time. On deposit of the amount, the same shall be credited in the account of District Legal Services Authority, Gurdaspur.

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In case, the amount is not paid, the Appellate Court shall
take appropriate steps to get the amount recovered.
