Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C raising a three fold prayer i.e. (i) to ensure release of an employee of the petitioner named Gurpreet Singh son of Paramjit Singh (ii) release of a blue colored tractor make Sonalika registered in the name of the sister of the petitioner and (iii) seeking protection of the life, liberty and property of the petitioner as also her family and for directing respondents no.3 to 5 not to interfere in the management of her agricultural land as also paddy crop situated in Village Hasanpur, Tehsil Mullanpur Dakha and Village Galib Kalan, Tehsil Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Counsel, at the very outset, apprises the Court that the prayers afore-noticed at serial numbers (i) and (ii) have been rendered infructuous and he does not press for the same.

In so far as prayer at serial number (iii) is concerned, the pleadings on record are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any

imminent danger and threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner. As regards the assertion that respondents no.3 to 5 are interfering with the management of her agricultural land, no interference in the instant petition is warranted as it would always be open for the petitioner to avail of her remedies in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
