This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 343 dated 24.10.2019, registered under Section 379B IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on), at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. The petitioner is not involved in any such crime as is alleged against him. In fact, the petitioner was involved by the police in 3 cases within a span of 2 days only, out of which in 2 cases, he was involved in a single day. Still further, it is submitted that the petitioner is in custody for about past 8 months. Even charge has not been framed so far. Therefore, the trial is likely to take long time. The petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Anmol Malik, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Naresh Kumar, has submitted that recovery of I-phone has been effected from the petitioner. Therefore, his complicity in the crime is established. It is further submitted that the petitioner is involved in 2 more cases. Further, it is not disputed that the petitioner has been in custody for about 8 months now and that even charge has not been framed so far.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
