The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.46 dated 21.02.2020 Under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 23.06.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mohan Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation. She further submits that on the basis of disclosure statement made by the petitioner's husband, certain documents have to be recovered from the petitioner. However, she has conceded that neither any allegation has been levelled against the petitioner in the FIR in question nor any role attributed to her.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 23.06.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
