1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.78 dated 07.04.2020, registered under Sections 323/324/148/149 & 326 (enhanced later on) IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 23.06.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the Police and recovery has also been effected from the petitioner and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Jagdeep Singh, states that that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 23.06.2020, the petitioner has joined investigation and he was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required. He

further states that recovery has also been effected.

5. In the light of the position as noted above, order dated 23.06.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
