This is second petition for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in a criminal case arising from FIR No.68 dated 12.7.2018 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act and Section 25 of NDPS Act added lateron) at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda. First petition was dismissed on 21.11.2019.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith two other co-accused were found in alleged conscious possession of 1750 intoxicated tablets TRIC SR alongwith 2050 intoxicated tablets of Prozolam 0.5.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that after the conclusion of the investigation, final report has been submitted and the prosecution has already examined five witnesses out of total 11 witnesses proposed to be examined.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner, particularly, when the alleged recovery is of commercial quantity.

However, learned Trial Court is requested to make sincere efforts for expeditious disposal of the case.
