On account of outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, the matter is taken up through video conferencing.

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.9 to 11 not to harass and humiliate the petitioners by holding an inquiry and thus causing harassment to them.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to consider and decide their representation Annexure P-4 in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent No.5 to look into the representation Annexure P-4 and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

4. The present petition stands disposed of.
