This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was previously married to Amandeep Singh (respondent No.4), however, she left his company and went to her parents house. It is pointed out that her parents wanted to re-marry her to an elderly person against her wishes. However, the petitioner refused to re-marry and later on, she left the house and joined the company of Amrinder Singh s/o Mejar Singh. It is the case of the petitioner that her husband and parents are threatening to eliminate her. According to the learned counsel, the representation dated 05.06.2020 submitted before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala has failed to evoke any response.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds that the petition lacks necessary particulars specifically the mode and

manner of the alleged threat extended to the petitioner. The pleadings in the petition do not inspire confidence. Resultantly, no case is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition stands dismissed.
