At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he restricts his arguments limited to the extent of expeditious decision on the legal notice dated 23.11.2019 (Annexure P-9), served by the petitioner to the respondents for counting the service period of his husband on daily wages for the purposes of calculating gratuity and other pensionary benefits as per the existing law.

Mr. Sehajbir Singh, Advocate, who is appearing through Video Conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the aforesaid legal notice shall be decided within a period of two months from today.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to decide the aforesaid legal notice within a period of two months from today and in case the petitioner is found entitled to any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to her within a period of two months thereafter.
