This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 144 dated 02.08.2019 registered under Section 376 IPC at Police Station Sadar Panipat.

Learned counsel for the State refers to the reply by way of affidavit filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samalkha, Panipat, wherein it has been observed in para vii. that no-one had committed snatching or given threats to kill the complainant Neeta nor she had been taken to police station on motorcycle by ASI Naresh Kumar and nor any signatures were obtained forcibly from her. The complainant got lodged the present FIR to extort money. It has further been observed that complainant is a clever lady and she is not known for good behaviour. She had filed complaints against her husband Krishan, in-laws and family members to the Superintendent of Police to make pressure upon them. She, on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh further submits that out of 19 witnesses, 2 witnesses have been examined.

Keeping in view that petitioner is in custody since 31.01.2020 and the trial will take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
