1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.50 dated 25.03.2020, registered under Sections 420/120-B IPC, 1860 at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.
3. Vide order dated 23.06.2020, while issuing notice of motion for today, it was ordered that in the meantime, the petitioner join investigation and in the event of his arrest, the petitioner be released on ad interim pre-arrest bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the orders of this Court referred to above, the petitioner joined investigation on 27.06.2020.
5. Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Bhupinder

Singh, confirms that pursuant to the orders of this Court, the petitioner joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

6. In view of the position as noted above, interim order dated 23.06.2020 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the terms & conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)Cr. P.C.
