B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the prayer for pre-arrest bail, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move an application for regular bail with the directions to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the same, preferably on the same day.
3. The same is not opposed to by learned DAG, Haryana, as well as learned counsel for the complainant.
4. In the circumstances, the petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, with the liberty as prayed for. The petitioner shall surrender before the learned trial Court on or before 15.07.2020. The petitioner would also be at liberty to move an application for regular bail. In case, any application for regular bail is moved, learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same, as expeditiously as possible, preferably on the same day.
