On account of outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, the matter is taken up through video conferencing.

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from respondents No.4 to 6 and take appropriate action in case FIR No.52 dated 16.03.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to consider and decide her representation dated 26.05.2020 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 26.05.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible

preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

4. The present petition stands disposed of.
