B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.

[2] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the petition for pre-arrest bail with liberty to file regular bail application before the learned trial Court and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the same as expeditiously as possible.

[3] Learned DAG, Punjab states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners.

[4] In the light of the position as noted above, the petition for pre-arrest bail is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty to the petitioners to move an application for regular bail before the learned trial Court. In case, any such application seeking regular bail is filed by the petitioners, the learned trial Court would consider and decide the same as expeditiously as possible.
