It has been stated that both the petitioners have attained the age for a valid marriage. The marriage of the petitioners has been solemnized on 16.6.2020. Copy of Aadhar card, marriage certificate and photographs are on record. The petitioners are stated to be residing at H.No. 3865, Sector 22-D, Chandigarh. Apprehending danger to their lives, at the instance of private respondents, the present petition has been instituted. The allegations are also substantiated with the affidavit of petitioner No.1.

It has been further stated that both the petitioners were married at the earlier instance but their marriages were dissolved vide separate decrees of divorce by mutual consent. Copy of the judgments and decree sheets dated 4.8.2017 and 5.9.2018 have been placed on record.

Mr. Lalit Kumar Gupta, Addl. Public Prosecutor, U.T. Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day through e-mail.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and if he finds that apprehension of danger to the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners is real, he shall take appropriate steps to ensure their protection as he feels necessary, in such circumstances of the case.

This order is not to be construed as any opinion with regard to the age of the petitioners or factum or validity of their marriage or any civil or criminal proceedings.
