Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.123 dated 06.10.2018, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC (Sections 353, 186 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners had given beatings to the complainant who was posted as a bodyguard to Mata Gursharan Kaur wife of Satguru Shri Uday Singh Ji at Shri Bhaini Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that due to party faction in the village, the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case; they are not involved in any other criminal case; the injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple injuries; under the interim order of this Court dated 23.06.2020 the petitioners have not only joined the investigation but they have also fully cooperated with the investigating agency and that since the investigation is over, the petitioners are not in a position to influence the same.

While admitting that the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed, learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioners have not only joined the investigation but have also fully cooperated with the investigating agency and that their custodial interrogation is no longer required by the State.

Keeping in view the totality of the facts as above as also statement made by learned State counsel that the petitioners have joined the investigation and have fully cooperated with the investigating agency and their custodial interrogation is not required, the order of this Court dated 23.06.2020 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
