1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.126 dated 02.06.2020, registered under Sections 384 and 506 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 24.06.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police and he was released on ad interim pre-arrest bail and further that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from SI Gurmit Singh, confirms that the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad interim pre-arrest bail and further his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the position as noted above, order dated 24.06.2020, is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
