Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.23 dated 19.02.2020, registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC (Section 304-B IPC added lateron), at Police Station New Colony, District Gurugram.

The petitioner is facing trial for suicidal death of his wife, who left a note (Annexure P-3), specifically naming petitioner for torturing and maltreating her on account of his demand of dowry or otherwise.

When the Bench was not inclined to grant the concession of regular bail to petitioner, learned counsel prayed for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
