Petitioners have filed this criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect their lives and liberty and provide police protection to them.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that at the instance of private respondents, petitioners are allegedly facing forcible dispossession from their property. Learned counsel fairly states that the civil litigation between the parties is also pending.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason to invoke extra ordinary writ jurisdiction as petitioners can avail alternative remedy before the Civil Court.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
