Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.182 dated 19.11.2018 under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated July 03, 2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurlal Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and

the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated July 03, 2020, is hereby made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
