Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Present petition was received by Email dated 12.06.2020 from Raju Sethi through email id rajusethi1111@gmail.com alongwith complaint/attachment dated nil made by Chamkaur Singh son of Amrik Singh r/o village Mudki, Tehsil and District Ferozepur and another email of even date made by Jasveer Kaur w/o Nachhattar Singh r/o Puran Singh Wali Basti, Zira, District Ferozepur.

Vide order dated 23.6.2020, reply was sought from the respondent-State.

In compliance thereof, reply/status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police (D), Ferozepur, has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State. In the report, it has been specifically mentioned that on 09.06.2020, a police party of CIA Staff, Ferozepur, had apprehended one

Baldev Singh son of Malkit Singh and recovered 20 grams Heroin from his possession and accordingly an FIR No. 52 dated 09.6.2020 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, was registered against him at Police Station Ghal Khurd. During interrogation, Baldev Singh got recorded his confessional statement that he alongwith petitioner-Chamkaur Bhatti are smuggling Heroin in the area and thereafter, the petitioner was indicted as co-accused in the present case.

Learned State counsel further points out that just to pressurize the State in the said case, the present petition has been filed. Two other FIR registered under NDPS Act are pending against the petitioner.

In view of the above, I am of the opinion that no case is made out.

Dismissed.
