The petitioner is presently arrayed as one of the accused in FIR No. 32 dated 18.09.2019 on the file of P.S. HSIIDC Barhi, Sonipat, registered under Section 379-B IPC (Sections 395, 397, 412 and 120-B IPC added later on). By way of this petition, he seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

The petitioner seems to have been implicated on the strength of the third disclosure statement made by one of the co-accused. Further, the record reflects that the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted anticipatory bail subject to conditions. That being so, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner would be entitled to similar protection subject to conditions.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing release of the petitioner in the event of his arrest in FIR No. 32 dated 18.09.2019 on the file of P.S. HSIIDC Barhi, Sonipat, subject to the petitioner furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
