This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No. 156 dated 05.10.2019 under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code 1860 registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

The allegations against the present petitioner are that he and his father-Puran Singh @ Samnpuran Singh had borrowed Rs.1,10,000/- from Amarjeet Singh and Rs. 3 lacs from Balwant Singh and in this transaction, the deceased Amarjeet Kaur had been introduced as a guarantor. Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to an affidavit given by Amarjit Singh (Annexure P-2) whereby he has categorically denied that petitioner borrowed money from him on the surety of Amarjit Kaur.

Learned counsel for the State has further informed that in the present case challan has been presented on 02.03.2020 and the petitioner is in custody since 05.01.2020. 15 witnesses are yet to be examined. The Coordinate Bench of this Court has already granted regular bail to Puran Singh @ Sampuran Singh in CRM-M-14780-2020 on 25.06.2020 with a

view that trial is not likely to conclude in near future.

Keeping in view above facts, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
